



## **Live Aloha Hawaiian Cultural Festival 2025 Sponsor Packet**

Aloha mai Prospective Sponsor!

The Live Aloha Hawaiian Cultural Festival (the “Event”) celebrates the arts and culture of Hawai’i in Seattle at the largest Hawaiian Festival in the Pacific Northwest. This FREE one-day, all inclusive event will take place on the grounds of the Seattle Center on September 7, 2025. The annual celebration showcases our Hawaiian culture through the presentation of art, music, hula, crafts, workshops, exhibits, and foods of Hawai’i. We are anticipating an attendance of 20,000+ people at the Event.

This family-oriented cultural Event is an opportunity for Washington residents to experience the culture of Hawai’i that is available right here in the Pacific Northwest. As of December 2023, the State of Washington Office of Financial Management reported 74,869 Native Hawaiians or other Pacific Islanders live in Washington state. This makes Washington the second largest state for Native Hawaiians living outside of Hawaii, after California. The recent Census indicates that in 2020, 47 percent of Native Hawaiians lived in Hawai’i, while 53 percent resided on the continent, contrasting with 2010 when 55 percent lived in Hawai’i and 45 percent in other states. As more families move away from Hawai’i to settle in Washington, many struggle to stay connected with “home” and the Hawaiian culture and resources. The Live Aloha Festival provides opportunities for children and adults in the Pacific Northwest to participate in the richness of Hawaiian culture, as well as connecting with others while enjoying live music, hula, and traditional crafts.

The Live Aloha Hawaiian Cultural Festival is Washington State’s premier Hawaiian cultural showcase, a celebration of Hawai’i’s music, hula, and history intended to preserve and perpetuate the unique island traditions.
